Project team for Manning upgrade

STAGE two of the \$100 million Manning Base Hospital Redevelopment has taken a major step forward with the appointment of a project team to masterplan the continued redevelopment.

Member for Myall Lakes, Stephen Bromhead was joined by the Deputy Premier and Minister for Regional NSW John Barilaro to make the announcement.

"The newly appointed project team will comprise of Health Infrastructure, Hunter New England Local Health District, Mace (consultant project manager), BVN (architect) and MBM (quantity surveyor)," Mr Bromhead said.

"I know access to quality healthcare is a huge issue for communities in Myall Lakes and in the lead-up to the last budget I fought tooth and nail in Parliament to ensure we secured this funding."

Mr Barilaro said the new project team will focus on master planning for the next stage of the project which will provide a clear framework to inform priority areas for the \$100 million redevelopment.

She began her professional career change undertaking an on-line course through


ganisers.
